

Dr. Anthony Tharp is the Assistant Dean for Facilities, Infrastructure & Risk Management (the FIRM) in the Vanderbilt School of Medicine Basic Sciences (VBS). Prior to serving in this role, he served as the Manager of the Cell and Developmental Biology Equipment Resource and The Vanderbilt Brain Institute Equipment Resource. He then became Administrative Director for the VBS Dean's Office where he oversaw space, capital assets, environmental health and safety and grant/internal funding support for faculty. During the COVID-19 pandemic, he was significantly involved with the planning and execution of the Basic Sciences COVID-19 response, coordinating access to public spaces and classrooms, procuring and distributing PPE and sanitizing supplies. He works closely with VU and VUMC Campus Planning on compliance, safety issues, and planning during everchanging facility and infrastructure needs to help ensure that Basic Sciences labs and administration have the best environment and tools in which to do their work.
